## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO AMEND THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT OF  
10 1967 TO EXEMPT HOME ADDRESSES AND PROPERTY TAX  
11 INFORMATION OF JUDGES AND PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS  
12 FROM DISCLOSURE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 TO AMEND THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT  
16 OF 1967 TO EXEMPT HOME ADDRESSES AND  
17 PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION OF JUDGES AND  
18 PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS FROM DISCLOSURE.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-19-105(b), concerning records not open  
24 to examination and copying, is amended to add an additional subdivision as  
25 follows:

26 (17) Home addresses and property tax assessment information of  
27 city court judges, district judges, state judges, federal judges and  
28 magistrates, prosecuting attorneys, deputy and assistant prosecuting  
29 attorneys, United States Attorneys, and assistant United States Attorneys.

31 SECTION 2. (a) Any county that maintains a website allowing access to  
32 property tax assessment records of the public shall not allow access to the  
33 information of city court judges, district judges, state judges, federal  
34 judges and magistrates, prosecuting attorneys, deputy and assistant  
35 prosecuting attorneys, United States Attorneys, and assistant United States  
36 Attorneys.
