## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DESEGREGATION LITIGATION  
10 OVERSIGHT SUBCOMMITTEE TO CONDUCT A COMPREHENSIVE  
11 FEASIBILITY STUDY TO FACILITATE A FINAL  
12 RESOLUTION TO DESEGREGATION CASES IN THE STATE;  
13 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

15 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DESEGREGATION  
16 LITIGATION OVERSIGHT SUBCOMMITTEE TO  
17 CONDUCT A COMPREHENSIVE FEASIBILITY  
18 STUDY TO FACILITATE A FINAL RESOLUTION  
19 TO DESEGREGATION CASES IN THE STATE.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 10, Chapter 3, Subchapter 15 is amended  
25 to add an additional section to read as follows:

26 10-3-1505. Comprehensive study.

27 (a)(1) The Desegregation Litigation Oversight Subcommittee may conduct  
28 a comprehensive feasibility study to facilitate a final resolution of the  
29 various desegregation cases in the state to which the State of Arkansas or  
30 its officers are a party.

31 (2) The study shall address matters as determined by the  
32 Desegregation Litigation Oversight Subcommittee.

33 (b)(1) The Desegregation Litigation Oversight Subcommittee may  
34 commission the assistance of experts or other unbiased sources to assist the  
35 Desegregation Litigation Oversight Subcommittee in the completion of a  
36 comprehensive feasibility study to facilitate a final resolution.
