BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-10-106 is amended to read as follows: 6-10-106. Uniform dates for beginning and end of school year.
(a)(1)(A) In each school year, the first day of the school year for student attendance in the public elementary and secondary schools of the State of Arkansas shall begin no earlier than August 19 and no later than August 26. If, however, August 18 falls on a Monday, school may begin on that date. The date for beginning the school year shall be determined by the school board of the school district on the first Monday following the second Saturday in August.
(B) Labor Day The following days shall be celebrated as a school holiday in all the school districts of the state, and school shall not be held on school shall be closed for the following holidays on the particular dates for each holiday as prescribed by the Director of the Department of Education:
(i) Ten (10) days for Christmas break;
(ii) Three (3) days for Thanksgiving;
