21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 60, Subchapter 1 is amended
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 5-60-123. Obstructing emergency medical personnel.

26 (a) It is unlawful for a person to obstruct or interfere with an
27 emergency medical technician, rescue technician, or any other emergency
28 medical care provider, whether governmental, private, or volunteer emergency
29 medical personnel, in the performance of his or her rescue mission.

30 (b)(1) Obstruction or interference with emergency medical personnel by
31 using or threatening to use physical force is a Class A misdemeanor.

32 (2) Obstruction or interference with emergency medical
33 personnel, other than by physical force or threatening physical force, is a
34 Class C misdemeanor.
