18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-117 is amended to read as follows:

21 6-17-117. Noninstructional duties.

22 (a)(1) The purpose of this section is to provide additional time for
23 instructional purposes and to reduce the amount of time for noninstructional
24 duties.

25 (2) Any teacher assigned more than ~~sixty (60)~~ seventy-five (75)
26 minutes of noninstructional duties per week shall be contracted in accordance
27 with § 6-17-807(g).

28 (b) For the purpose of this section, "noninstructional duty" means the
29 supervision of students before or after the instructional day begins or ends
30 for students or for the supervision of students during breakfasts, lunches,
31 recesses, or scheduled breaks.

32 (c) For the purpose of this section, "instructional purposes" means
33 activities initiated by the teacher related to teaching duties, including,
34 but not limited to, contacting parents, assessing student performance,
35 documenting student performance, organizing the classroom, preparing
36 instructional materials, and other teaching responsibilities related to



1 instructional planning and the direct instruction of students.
