19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-39-211(a), concerning unlawful mining a	ınd
22	entries into cemeteries, is amended to read as follows:	
23	(a) It shall be unlawful for any corporation, company, or individual	-
24	to:	
25	(1) Mine, extract, or remove coal or any other mineral <del>or</del>	
26	substance from under, or within fifty feet (50') of the boundar	<u>.y</u>
27	$\underline{\text{of}}$ any cemetery, graveyard, or burying place in this state;	
28	(2) Make, place, or drive any slope, pit, or entry of any kind	Į
29	into, under, through, or across any cemetery, graveyard, or other burying	
30	place in this state.

32	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-39-212 is amended to read as follows:	
33	5-39-212. Cemeteries - Access - Debris - Disturbance.	
34	(a) $\underline{(1)}$ It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation,	
35	partnership, or association to:	
36	(2) Construct construct any fence on any property in such mann	ıer

- l as to enclose any cemetery unless suitable reasonable access by automobile to
- 2 the cemetery is provided by gate or otherwise. The word "cemetery", as used
- 3 in this subsection, is not intended to apply to any private family burial
- 4 plot which contains fewer than six (6) commercial grave markers and has not
- 5 been used for burial purposes for at least twenty-five (25) years and which
- 6 has not had an access road to the burial plot for at least thirty (30) years.
- 7 (3) Nothing in this section prohibits the placement of a fence
- 8 around any cemetery for the purpose of defining boundaries or protection of
- 9 grave sites; if all fences and gates are sufficiently maintained.
- 10 (b)(1) Any person, firm, corporation, partnership, or association
- 11 violating any of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a
- 12 misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than ten
- dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100), and every day that
- 14 the violation shall exist shall be a separate offense.
- 15 (2) Fines collected shall be used by the local government toward
- 16 upkeep, maintenance, and administrative costs of abandoned cemeteries.
- 17 (c) As used in this section, "cemetery" means any burying place for
- 18 the dead, a burial plot, or a graveyard on any land, public or private, that
- includes one (1) or more grave sites, whether marked or unmarked, by
- 20 commercial or native stone.

- 22 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-39-401 is amended to read as follows:
- 23 5-39-401. Destruction or removal.
- It is unlawful for any person, corporation, company, or other entity to
- 25 destroy or carry away any cemetery marker or grave marker.

- 27 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 5-71-215(a), concerning defacing of objects
- 28 of public respect, is amended to read as follows:
- 29 (a) A person commits the offense of defacing objects of public respect
- 30 if he <u>or she</u> purposely:
- 31 (1) Defaces, mars, or otherwise damages any public monument;
- 32 (2) Defaces, mars, or otherwise damages a work of art on display
- 33 in any public place; or
- 34 (3) Defaces, mars, desecrates, or otherwise damages any place of
- 35 worship, cemetery, or burial monument+; or
- 36 (4) Removes broken or unbroken, commercial or rock grave markers

1	for any reason except for cleaning or repair by a family member, caretaker,
2	or preservation organization.
3	
4	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 13-6-408(c), concerning desecration of
5	burial grounds and burial furniture, is amended to read as follows:
6	(c) Exempted from this section is disturbance of human skeletal burial
7	remains or burial furniture by landowners or agricultural tenants as a
8	consequence of agricultural activity or any other activity unless the
9	landowner or agricultural tenant knowingly desecrates or knowingly allows
10	desecration of a cemetery or burial site.
