For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO MEMBERS OF THE
ARKANSAS NATIONAL GUARD AND RESERVES WHO ARE
CALLED INTO ACTIVE DUTY BY PRESERVING THE
MEMBERS' CUSTODIAL RIGHTS FOR THEIR CHILDREN,
ENSURING THAT THE MEMBERS' RIGHT TO PARENT THAT
IS SECURED BY THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED
STATES IS ADEQUATELY PROTECTED, AND PROTECTING
THE MEMBERS' RIGHTS IN REGARD TO THE DISSOLUTION
OF THEIR MARRIAGES AND CUSTODY AND SUPPORT OF
THEIR CHILDREN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PRESERVE THE CUSTODIAL RIGHTS OF
MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS NATIONAL GUARD
AND RESERVES WHO ARE CALLED INTO ACTIVE
DUTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to provide assistance to members
of the Arkansas National Guard and Reserves who are called into active duty
by:

- (1) Preserving the members' custodial rights for their children;
- (2) Ensuring that the members' right to parent that is secured
by the Constitution of the United States is adequately protected; and
- (3) Protecting the members' rights in regard to the dissolution
of their marriages and custody and support of their children.
