24 (c) For purposes of the salary schedules described in this section, 25 the teacher's experience shall be his or her total years in any school 26 district in the state and shall not be based only upon the years in the 27 school district in which he or she is currently employed.

28 (d)(1) A teacher shall be entitled to additional pay for the school 29 year if the number of days in the teacher's contract for the 2004-2005 30 current school year exceeds the number of days in the teacher's contract for 31 the 2003-2004 immediately preceding school year.

32 (2) The additional pay shall be at least equal to the number of 33 additional contract days under subdivision (d)(1) of this section multiplied by the daily rate calculated using the teacher's 2003-2004 previous year's 34 35 salary from the immediately preceding school year.

(c)(1) A teacher shall not be entitled to additional pay under
