## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT TWO (2) MEMBERS OF THE  
10 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD BE APPOINTED  
11 FROM DRY COUNTIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

14 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE ALCOHOLIC  
15 BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD HAVE AT LEAST TWO  
16 (2) MEMBERS FROM DRY COUNTIES.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-2-201(b), pertaining to the Alcoholic  
22 Beverage Control Board, is amended to read as follows:

23 (b)(1) The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall consist of five (5)  
24 persons, according to the following requirements:

25 (A) Two (2) of the members shall be from counties in which  
26 the manufacture or sale of intoxicating liquor is prohibited;

27 (B) All members shall be appointed by the Governor;

28 (C) All members shall be subject to confirmation by the  
29 Senate; and

30 (D) All members shall serve for a term of six (6) years.

31 (2) The requirement in subdivision (b)(1)(A) of this section  
32 shall be met as the terms of existing board members expire.
