6	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-18-201(f), concerning the age for		
7	compulsory attendance for school enrollment, is amended to read as follows:		
8	(f) Any Beginning with the 2006-2007 school year, any child who will		
9	be six (6) years of age on or before October 1 <u>June</u> 1 of <u>immediately</u>		
10	proceeding the school year of enrollment and who has not completed a state-		
11	accredited kindergarten program shall be evaluated by the district and may be		
12	placed in the first grade if the results of the evaluation justify placement		
13	in this first grade and the child's parent agrees with placement in the first		
14	grade. Otherwise, the child shall be placed in kindergarten.		
15			
16	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-18-207(a)(1), concerning the minimum age		
17	for enrollment in public school, is amended to read as follows:		
18	(a)(1) Students may enter kindergarten in the public schools of this		
19	state if they will attain the age of five (5) years on or before September 1		
20	$\underline{\text{June 1}}$ of $\underline{\text{immediately proceeding}}$ the year in which they are seeking initial		
21	enrollment.

23	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
24	Eighty-fifth General Assembly that immediate passage of this act is necessary		
25	to eliminate uncertainty for parents of children approaching the age for		
26	school enrollment and to alleviate hardship to local school districts in		
27	planning for the next school year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
28	exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the		
29	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on the date of its		
30	approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the		
31	Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time		
32	during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the		
33	Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date		
34	the last house overrides the veto.
