AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT THE TEACHER DAILY PLANNING PERIOD OCCURS DURING THE STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114(a)(2), concerning the daily planning period for teachers, is amended to read as follows:
(2) (A) The planning time shall be in increments of no less than forty (40) minutes during the student instructional day.
(B) A teacher who does not receive the planning time required under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section during the student instructional day shall be compensated at his or her hourly rate of pay for each missed planning period.
(C) A school district shall be exempt from the provisions of this subdivision (a)(2) if it:
(i) Has collectively negotiated a contract through a

## local teacher's association; and

(ii) The collectively negotiated contract expressly provides for a teacher's daily planning period.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114, concerning the daily planning
