19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-609 is amended to read as follows:

22 19-4-609. Productivity reporting.

23 (a) Each state agency, other than the elected constitutional officers,  
24 shall institute and maintain a program to increase the productivity and cost  
25 effectiveness of the employees for which they are responsible.

26 (b)(1) Each executive, judicial, legislative, and any other agency of  
27 the state shall provide, on a calendar-monthly basis, information reflecting  
28 the number of current employees in each such agency, the number of newly  
29 hired employees, the number of employees who have transferred to other state  
30 agencies, the number of employees who retired, the number of all other  
31 separations of employees, the number of current vacant authorized positions,  
32 and such other information as may be requested.

33 (2) Each executive, judicial, legislative, and any other agency  
34 of the State of Arkansas shall provide, on a quarterly basis, a statement of  
35 the reasons for any vacant authorized positions.

36 ~~(2)(3)~~ The information shall be compiled on forms developed by



1 the Bureau of Legislative Research and submitted to the Legislative Council  
2 on a calendar-quarterly basis.
