(a) Any person violating the provisions of this subchapter or 3 4 attempting to secure the benefits of this subchapter who is not entitled to 5 the benefits of it shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. 6 (b)(1) Upon conviction, a violator shall be required to pay the normal 7 license fee for legally issued license plates and, in addition, shall be 8 fined in the sum of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) nor more than 9 one thousand dollars (\$1,000). 10 (2) Costs as provided by law in misdemeanor offenses shall be 11 assessed. 12 13 27-15-403. License plates furnished - Fees. 14 (a)(1) Any American veteran who is a citizen and resident of the State 15 of Arkansas, who is determined by the United States Department of Veterans 16 Affairs to be a totally and permanently disabled service connected veteran, 17 have a permanent service-connected disability rating of seventy percent (70%) or more and who is the owner of an automobile which is to be used by, or for, 18 19 the totally and permanently disabled veteran, shall be provided, upon application, state automobile license plates free of charge, upon 20 21 presentation of proof of the automobile owned by the totally and permanently 22 disabled service-connected veteran. 2.3 (2) However, there shall be a payment annually of one dollar 24 (\$1.00) to defray the cost of the issuance and renewal. 25 (b) Any county, city, or town in this state is forbidden from 26 requiring any license or payment of any fee for any such motor vehicle 27 license plates for the privilege of operating any such automobile upon the 28 roads, streets, or alleys of any county, city, or town. 29 30 27-15-404. Design. 31 License plates furnished under this subchapter shall be of distinctive 32 design prepared by the Director of the Department of Finance and 33 Administration to indicate thereon the words "Disabled Veteran". 34 35 27-15-405. Limitations.

(a) No totally or permanently disabled service-connected veteran A

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1 veteran who has a permanent service-connected disability rating of seventy 2 percent (70%) or more shall only be entitled to own or operate more than one 3 (1) motor vehicle with free license plates as provided in this subchapter. 4 (b) Any person entitled to a free special disabled American veteran 5 license plate under § 27-15-403 may obtain one (1) additional set of disabled 6 American veteran license plates for his or her other motor vehicles upon 7 payment of the normal fee for licensing such motor vehicles. 8 27-15-406. Transferability. 9 10 Any motor vehicle license plates issued under the provisions of this 11 subchapter shall not be transferred to any person not entitled to receive 12 such license plates as provided in this subchapter. 13 27-15-407. Rights of surviving spouse. 14 15 The surviving spouse of a deceased disabled veteran, as defined in 16 this subchapter, shall, upon payment annually of one dollar (\$1.00) to defray 17 the cost of the issuance and renewal, be issued the special disabled American 18 veteran license plate provided for in this subchapter. 19 The surviving spouse shall not be eligible for parking privileges in designated accessible parking spaces for persons with disabilities unless 20 21 the surviving spouse is a person with a disability, as defined in § 27-15-22 302(3). 2.3 24 27-15-408. Parking privileges for disabled veterans. 25 A vehicle displaying a special "disabled veteran" license plate issued 26 to a totally and permanently disabled service-connected veteran who has a 27 permanent service-connected disability rating of seventy percent (70%) or 28 more under § 27-15-403, or a valid "disabled veteran" license plate issued by 29 another state, and being used for the actual transporting of a disabled 30 veteran is permitted parking privileges in those areas designated for parking only by persons with disabilities under the Access to Parking for Persons 31 32 with Disabilities Act, §§ 27-15-301 et seg. 33 34 35

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
