For An Act To Be Entitled

TO PROVIDE THAT THE HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEE AND
SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND
GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS PERFORM AN INTERIM STUDY
CONCERNING THE REORGANIZATION OF STATE
GOVERNMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROVIDE THAT THE HOUSE INTERIM
COMMITTEE AND SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE
ON STATE AGENCIES AND GOVERNMENTAL
AFFAIRS PERFORM AN INTERIM STUDY
CONCERNING THE REORGANIZATION OF STATE
GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) The House Interim Committee and Senate Interim
Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs shall conduct a study of
the reorganization of state government.

(b) The committees may employ a consultant or consultants to assist
the committees in the study of the reorganization of state government.

(c) The committees may request that any combination of the House of
Representatives, Senate, and Legislative Council participate by making funds
available for the study.

(d) The committees shall complete the study and make their findings
and recommendations by October 31, 2006.
