HOUSE BILL 2833

For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DRIVERS OF MOTORCYCLES TO
10 PROCEED THROUGH AN INTERSECTION CONTROLLED BY A
11 TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICE ONLY IF THE TRAFFIC-
12 CONTROL DEVICE USES A VEHICLE SENSOR THAT FAILS
13 TO DETECT THE MOTORCYCLE BECAUSE OF ITS SIZE OR
14 WEIGHT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 TO ALLOW THE DRIVERS OF MOTORCYCLES TO
17 PROCEED THROUGH AN INTERSECTION
18 CONTROLLED BY A TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICE
19 UNDER LIMITED CIRCUMSTANCES.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 52, Subchapter 2 is amended
26 to add an additional section to read as follows:

27 27-52-206. Exception for motorcycles.

28 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if a driver of a motorcycle
29 approaches an intersection that is controlled by a traffic-control device,
30 the driver may proceed through the intersection on a red light only if:

31 (1) The traffic-control device uses a vehicle sensor;

32 (2) The vehicle sensor has failed to detect the motorcycle
33 because of the motorcycle's size or weight; and

34 (3) The driver:

35 (A) Comes to a full and complete stop at the intersection;

36 (B) Exercises due care as provided by law; and



1 (C) Proceeds with caution through the intersection when it
2 is safe to do so.

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
