9	public school children who ride on school buses; that these requirements can			
10	<u>be avoided in school districts where bus drivers go on strike due to a</u>			
11	loophole in the law that allows school districts to employ temporary or			
12	provisional employees; and this act is immediately necessary to close the			
13	loophole in the law that jeopardizes the safety of public school children who			
14	ride on buses to school. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and			
15	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public			
16	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:			
17	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;			
18	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,			
19	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
