17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Title.

20 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Eye Protection Act Of
21 2005".

23 SECTION 2. *Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 90, Subchapter 1 is amended*
24 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

25 17-90-111. Jewelry eye implants.

26 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, no person
27 shall implant jewelry into the mucous membrane of the eye of another person.

28 (b) The Arkansas State Medical Board may authorize and regulate the
29 practice of implanting jewelry into the mucous membrane of an eye.
