17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-3-203 is amended to read as follows:
20 5-3-203. Classification.

21 A criminal attempt is a:

22 (1) Class Y felony if the offense attempted is capital murder;

23 ~~(1)(2)~~ Class A felony if the offense attempted is ~~capital~~
24 ~~murder~~, treason, or a Class Y felony other than capital murder;

25 ~~(2)(3)~~ Class B felony if the offense attempted is a Class A
26 felony;

27 ~~(3)(4)~~ Class C felony if the offense attempted is a Class B
28 felony;

29 ~~(4)(5)~~ Class D felony if the offense attempted is a Class C
30 felony;

31 ~~(5)(6)~~ Class A misdemeanor if the offense attempted is a Class D
32 felony or an unclassified felony;

33 ~~(6)(7)~~ Class B misdemeanor if the offense attempted is a Class A
34 misdemeanor;

35 ~~(7)(8)~~ Class C misdemeanor if the offense attempted is a Class B
36 misdemeanor; and



1 ~~(8)~~(9) Violation if the offense attempted is a Class C
2 misdemeanor or an unclassified misdemeanor.
