24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

SECTION 1. Intent.

26
27 (a) The General Assembly finds that:

28 (1) The actions of state government have produced a substantial
29 increase in the number of agencies, departments, boards, commissions,
30 institutions, and programs of this state, growth of pre-existing programs,
31 and the proliferation of rules;

32 (2) The growth of state government has developed without
33 sufficient legislative oversight, regulatory accountability, or a system of
34 checks and balances; and

35 (3) By establishing a system for the termination, study, review,
36 continuation, or re-establishment of such agencies, it will be in a better



1 position to evaluate the need for the continued existence of existing and
2 future agencies, departments, boards, commissions, institutions, and programs
3 of the state government.

4 (b) The intent of this act is to establish an orderly schedule for the
5 abolishment of all existing state agencies during a twelve-year period, but
6 to make provision for review by the Government Efficiency and Accountability
7 Review Subcommittee of the House and Senate Interim Committees on State
8 Agencies and Governmental Affairs to enable the General Assembly to have the
9 benefit of recommendations for the continuation of those state agencies which
10 are deemed to be essential for the necessary and efficient operation of
11 government prior to the abolishment.

13 SECTION 2. (a) The following state agencies, and all departments,

16 30, 2007, unless continued by action of the General Assembly or transferred

27 SECTION 3. This act shall not be construed to extend or renew any
28 state agency or any department, board, commission, institution, division,
29 program, service, advisory committee, or council of any state agency
30 scheduled to expire or terminate on a specific date separate and apart from
31 the provisions of this act.

33 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective only if House Bill 2623 of
34 the Regular Session of the Eighty-fifth General Assembly, dealing with the
35 creation of the Government Efficiency and Accountability Review Subcommittee
36 of the House and Senate Interim Committees on State Agencies and Governmental

1 Affairs, is approved by the Governor, becomes law upon the expiration of the
2 period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill, or becomes law by
3 an override of a veto by the General Assembly.
