1	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
2	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the results of state mandated
3	assessments will soon be available to students, parents and school districts;
4	that to provide the most accurate information the results need to be made
5	available to the school district where the child resides. This act is
6	immediately necessary so that the Department of Education may provide the
7	assessment to the appropriate school district. Therefore, an emergency is
8	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
9	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
10	<u>on:</u>
11	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
12	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
13	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
14	bill; or
15	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
16	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
