20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GEN	ERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF A	ARKANSAS:
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22	SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to require the Department of		
23	Education to promulgate rules necessary for the implementation of the highly		
24	qualified teacher provision of the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001,		
25	20 U.S.C.S. § 6301 et se	q., as in existence on January	1, 2005.

27	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
28	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is an immediate need for		
29	guidance in the implementation of the highly qualified teacher provision of		
30	the No Child Left Behind Act, that without such requirements federal funding		
31	for education could be lost; and that this act is immediately necessary to		
32	bring the state into compliance before the beginning of the school year.		
33	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately		
34	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
35	become effective on:

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(2) If the bill is heither approved nor veloed by the Governor,
the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
