23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to allow hotel owners in certain  
26 historic districts in tourist towns with a population not exceeding five  
27 thousand (5,000) to serve alcoholic beverages and other beverages regulated  
28 by the Alcohol and Beverage Control Board and to retain any other licenses  
29 necessary for such purpose.
