9 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF LARGE TRUCK
10 TIRES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

13 TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF LARGE
14 TRUCK TIRES.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18

19 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-9-403(c), regarding the operation of*
20 *waste tire sites, requirements, and prohibited activities, is amended to read*
21 *as follows:*

22 *(c)(1) A person shall not maintain a waste tire site unless the site*
23 *is an integral part of that person's or another person's permitted waste tire*
24 *processing facility or collection center.*

25 *(2) It is illegal for any person to dispose of used or waste*
26 *tires or portions of used or waste tires in the state, unless such tires are*
27 *disposed of for processing, or collected for processing, at a permitted waste*
28 *tire processing facility, at a waste tire site which is an integral part of a*
29 *permitted waste tire processing facility, at a waste tire collection center,*
30 *or at a permitted solid waste disposal facility.*

31 *(3)(A) Three (3) years after the effective date of this act,*
32 *only passenger tires that do not exceed a rim diameter of nineteen and one-*
33 *half inches (19 1/2") shall be disposed at a disposal site that has a permit*
34 *issued to operate as a monofill landfill:*

35 *(i) Tires that have been processed by cutting,*
36 *shredding, or splitting into sufficiently small parts to ensure proper*



1 disposal; or

2 (ii) Tires that are processed by baling.

3 (B) Whole tires that exceed a rim diameter of nineteen and
4 one-half inches (19 1/2") may be placed in a permitted tire monofill without
5 cutting, shredding, splitting, or baling.

6 (C) Passenger tires with a rim diameter of nineteen and
7 one-half inches (19 1/2") that are cut, shredded, or split may be used as
8 daily or intermediate covering in all landfills in lieu of soil or other
9 acceptable covering for waste materials.

10 ~~(3)~~(4) (A) Whole tires shall not be deposited in a landfill as a
11 method of ultimate disposal unless shredded or split into sufficiently small
12 parts to assure their proper disposal.

13 (B) Whole tires shall not be disposed of in a landfill
14 containing any other type of waste unless the tires are disposed of in a
15 separate area of the landfill and the area has been prepared in such a manner
16 that the tires can be recovered at a later date.

17 ~~(4)~~(5) A person who leases or owns real property may use waste
18 tires for soil erosion abatement and drainage purposes in accordance with
19 procedures approved by the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission
20 and each solid waste management district or to secure covers over silage,
21 hay, straw, or agricultural products.
