5	(2) Shall be operated as a division within the department; and		
6	(3) Shall perform the functions and duties as provided in this		
7	subchapter.		
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9	15-4-3104. Division of Job Creation-Administrator.		
10	(a) The Governor shall appoint an Administrator of the Division of Job		
11	Creation of the Department of Economic Development.		
12	(b) The administrator shall direct the day-to-day operations of the		
13	division.

15	15-4-3105. Division of Job Creation-Duties.		
16	(a) The Division of Job Creation of the Department of Economic		
17	Development shall assist the Department of Economic Development and the		
18	<u>Division of Minority Business Enterprise of the Department of Economic</u>		
19	Development in:		
20	(1) The creation of job opportunities in each of the four (4)		
21	congressional districts of the state;		
22	(2) Developing a twenty-year plan to transform Arkansas		
23	communities by the creation of job opportunities in each of the four (4)		
24	congressional districts of the state;		
25	(3) Developing technology-based businesses through cluster-based		
26	development practices;		
27	(4) Developing information and telecommunications-based		
28	businesses in the State of Arkansas; and

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2	15-4-3106. Job Creation Council established - Duties.		
3	(a) The Job Creation Council is established and it shall represent th		
4	Division of Job Creation of the Department of Economic Development.		
5	(b)(1) The council shall consist of seven (7) members appointed as		
6	follows:		
7	(A) The Governor shall appoint two (2) members with the		
8	advice and consent of the Senate;		
9	(B) The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint one (1) member		
10	with the advice and consent of the Senate;		
11	(C) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint		
12	two (2) members; and		
13	(D) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall		
14	appoint two (2) members.		
15	(2)(A) Appointments shall be representative of the business		
16	community in each of the four (4) congressional districts of the state.		
17	(B) Each of the four (4) congressional districts of the		
18	state shall be represented on the council.		
19	(c) Members shall serve on the council at the pleasure of the		
20	appointing officer.		
21	(d) Except as otherwise provided by law, members of the council shall		
22	serve without compensation.		
23	(e) The council shall:		
24	(1) Monitor progress, make recommendations, and develop		
25	strategic plans for performance improvement; and		
26	(2) Report to the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the		
27	Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the		
28	Senate.		
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
