26	entering politics and became an exceptional leader in the State of Arkansas;

29	WHEREAS, Mr. Cash served as past presidents of the Trumann Lions Club
30	and MidSouth Farm Equipment Dealers Association; served on the boards of
31	directors for Liberty Bank and St. Bernard's Foundation; received a
32	bachelor's degree from Arkansas State University where he was recognized as a
33	Distinguished Alumnus of the College of Business; and was a member of First
34	Baptist Church in Jonesboro, the University Heights Lions Club, and Trumann
35	Masonic Lodge No. 693; and

1	WHEREAS, Mr. Cash served two (2) terms in the Arkansas House of
2	Representatives where he became the first freshman representative to be
3	elected to the Joint Budget Committee; and served one (1) term in the Senate;
4	and

6	WHEREAS, Mr. Cash was known for his bipartisan leadership, an
7	unwavering dedication to his constituents, and his sharp legislative mind;
8	and

10	WHEREAS, Mr. Cash was a fearless champion for the causes in which he
11	believed though the subject might be unpopular and controversial; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, Mr. Cash was trusted by friends and competitors alike, as he
14	always chose the honorable path; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, Mr. Cash was preceded in death by his parents, Vernon and
17	Lucille Cash, and two brothers; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, Mr. Cash is survived by his wife, Joan Cash; one son, Greg
20	Cash of Pocahontas, Arkansas; one daughter, Jennifer Linton of Lonoke,
21	Arkansas; one sister, Carol White of Trumann, Arkansas; and five
22	grandchildren; and

24	WHEREAS, the House of Representatives of the Eighty-fifth General
25	Assembly of the State of Arkansas wishes to publicly recognize Mr. Cash's
26	many contributions to the State of Arkansas and his local community,
