21 WHEREAS, the men and women of our United States Armed Forces now
22 serving in the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Merchant
23 Marines, National Guard and Reserves have shown great courage and self-
24 sacrifice and deserve to be equipped with the best weapons and resources to
25 protect our nation; and

27 *WHEREAS, in past years, the defense appropriations bill has been*
28 *delayed until late in the budget year; and*

30 WHEREAS, in the wake of the terrorist attacks on America on September
31 11, 2001, President Bush asked that the United States Congress pass the
32 Defense Appropriations bill before passing other spending bills; and

34 WHEREAS, Congress acted responsibly in the 2002, 2003, and 2004 budgets
35 when it passed the Defense Appropriations bill first, thereby protecting the
36 men and women in our armed forces from becoming pawns for politicians'

3 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-
4 FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING

7 THAT the Eighty-fifth General Assembly commends Congress for making our
8 nation's defense its first priority in 2002, 2003, and 2004 and requests that
9 the Congressmen and Senators from our state continue this important tradition
10 by passing and enacting the defense appropriations legislation before all
11 other spending bills in 2005 and in future years.
