## Subtitle

CONCERNING LEGISLATIVE CONTRACTS FOR STUDIES TO BE CONDUCTED BY OUTSIDE CONTRACTORS .

WHEREAS, from time to time, various legislative committees seek approval for contracts for outside consultants to conduct a study; and

WHEREAS, it would be helpful to the members of the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas who were not a part of the approval and monitoring of the contract, if information concerning the history of the request and the contract were provided to members of the General Assembly when the report is presented,

NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That when the General Assembly, a committee of the General Assembly, or an agency of the legislative branch contracts for the preparation of a study, that legislative staff shall prepare an information sheet to accompany the report when it is presented to the General Assembly or a committee of the General Assembly, and the information sheet shall include the following information:
(1) Which legislator or committee requested the study;
(2) A summary of the study request;
(3) Whether other bids were submitted;
(4) Which legislator or committee approved the contract;
(5) The contract price and the amount paid under the contract;
(6) The date the contract was entered into; and
(7) The date the report was due and whether the report was submitted on time.
