20	communications has become an ordinary part of the work and recreation of all
21	Arkansans; and

23	WHEREAS, young people are increasingly at risk from adult predators who
24	use the Internet for solicitation and other harmful reasons; and
2526	WHEREAS, there is a need to increase the awareness of all Arkansans
27	about the risks of predatory conduct on the Internet; and
28	about the fisks of predatory conduct on the internet, and
29	WHEREAS, the Attorney General of Arkansas has developed the "Keys to
30	Safety" program to educate young people about online safety and teach them
31	about other protective measures; and

33	WHEREAS, a local Arkansan, Jillian Bridges, has made the promotion of
34	public awareness of the dangers of surfing the Internet a part of her
35	platform as Miss Teen Arkansas Valley; and
