36	SECTION 1. Section 5 of Article 5 of the Arkansas Constitution is

- 3 <u>(a)</u> The General Assembly shall meet at the seat of government every 4 two years, on the first Tuesday after the second Monday in November, until

14	§ 3. Excepting monies raised or collected for educational purposes,
15	highway purposes, to pay Confederate pensions and the just debts of the
16	State, the General Assembly is hereby prohibited from appropriating or
17	expending more than the sum of Two and One-Half Million Dollars for all
18	purposes, for any biennial period fiscal year; provided the limit herein
19	fixed may be exceeded by the votes of three-fourths of the members elected to
20	each House of the General Assembly. [As added to Art. 5 by Const. Amend. 19.]

22	SECTION 6. Section 40 of Article 5 of the Arkansas Constitution is
23	amended to read as follows:
24	[§ 40.] General appropriation bill - Enactment.
25	§ 4. In making appropriations for any biennial period fiscal year, the
26	General Assembly shall first pass the General Appropriation Bill provided for
27	in Section 30 of Article 5 of the Constitution, and no other appropriation
28	bill may be enacted before that shall have been done. [As added to Art. 5 by
29	Const. Amend. 19.]

31	SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This amendment shall become effective on
32	January 1, 2007.
