33	SECTION 1	. Section 14 of Article 19 of the Arkansas Constitut	ion i	S
34	amended to read	as follows:		
35	§ 14. Lo	tteries prohibited .		
36	No lotter	y shall be authorized by this State, nor shall the sa	le of	



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1	lottery tickets be allowed.
2	(a) Except as specifically provided in this section, all lotteries and
3	the sale of lottery tickets are prohibited.
4	(b)(1) The General Assembly may by law define lottery and provide for
5	the operation and regulation of a lottery by or on behalf of the state, and
6	for any matters relating to the purposes or provisions of this section.
7	(2) Proceeds derived from the lottery operated by or on behalf
8	of the state shall be deposited into financial institutions other than the
9	State Treasury and used to pay the operating expenses of the lottery,
10	including all prizes, without any appropriation required by law, and all
11	remaining proceeds shall be deposited into the State Treasury to supplement,
12	not supplant, appropriations provided by the General Assembly for public
13	school facilities for grades kindergarten through twelve (K-12).
14	(3)(A) The remaining proceeds after payment of the operating
15	expenses of the lottery, including prizes, shall be separately accounted for
16	and together with any interest accumulated on the funds transferred
17	immediately to the State Treasury for deposit into the Public Schools
18	Facilities Trust Fund.
19	(B) The General Assembly may only appropriate funds from
20	the Public School Facilities Trust Fund for purposes relating to the
21	construction, renovation, purchase, or maintenance of public school
22	facilities for grades kindergarten through twelve (K-12).
23	(C) For the purpose of this section, "the construction,
24	renovation, purchase, or maintenance" means such expenses related to the
25	construction, renovation, purchase, or maintenance of public school
26	facilities for grades kindergarten through twelve (K-12) as may be defined by
27	a law.
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29	SECTION 2. This amendment becomes effective on January 1, 2007.
