22 WHEREAS, Dr. Roger Worsley graduated from Arizona State University with
23 a Bachelor of Arts degree in Education in 1959, a Master of Science degree in
24 1962, and a Doctor of Education degree in Educational Administration in 1969;
25 and

27 WHEREAS, Dr. Worsley received a full athletic scholarship for the years
28 1955 to 1959; was elected to Phi Delta Kappa in 1959; and was Vice President
29 of Phi Epsilon Kappa Fraternity in 1959; and

31 WHEREAS, Dr. Worsley was honored as an Outstanding Educator of America
32 in 1971 and a Leader in Education in 1974; and was listed in the Biography of
33 Notable Americans in 1976, the Who's Who in the West in 1984, and Oxford's
34 Who's Who in 1992; and

36 WHEREAS, Dr. Worsley joined Southern Arkansas University Tech in



1 November 1996, and during his tenure the school enrollment has grown from
2 seven hundred (700) students to over two thousand one hundred (2,100)
3 students making it the fastest-growing college in Arkansas; Southern Arkansas
4 University Tech had a growth rate of 24.6% in the fall semester of 2004 and
5 has maintained its position as the fastest-growing college in the state with
6 an increase of 26.7% this semester; and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Worsley has enjoyed his time at the university and that
9 with the innovation of the Internet classes, the burgeoning concurrent
10 enrollment figures, the location of the Career Academy on campus, and the
11 scholarship program for firefighters and police officers to complete their
12 degrees, he believes enrollment will remain high; and

14 WHEREAS, Dr. Worsley has overseen the growth in training for local
15 industries and has ensured that the Career Center will pay off in the growth
16 of the technical programs on campus; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Worsley recently announced that he will be retiring as
19 Chancellor in June 2005 but will stay with the university until a replacement
20 is found for him; and

22 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives of the Eighty-fifth General
23 Assembly wishes to publicly commend Dr. Roger Worsley on his many
24 contributions to education and on his dedication and achievements as
25 Chancellor of Southern Arkansas University Tech,

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIFTH GENERAL
29 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
