2	WHEREAS, it is the public policy of the State of Arkansas to recognize
3	the marital union only of one man and one woman; and
4	
5	WHEREAS, in 2004, the people of Arkansas overwhelmingly passed an
6	amendment to the Arkansas Constitution that specifically defined marriage as
7	being between only one man and one woman; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, the amendment to the Arkansas Constitution defining marriage
10	as being between only one man and one woman passed with seventy-five percent
11	(75%) of the vote; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, a majority of voters in each of Arkansas' seventy-five (75)
14	counties voted for the amendment defining marriage; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, recently there have been serious attempts to change the
17	historical definition of marriage through legislation and judicial action;
18	and
19	INTEDEAC recent court estion outside of Ankenges may iconomics the
20 21	WHEREAS, recent court action outside of Arkansas may jeopardize the enforcement of Arkansas' Defense of Marriage Act and the amendment to the
22	Arkansas Constitution defining marriage,
