abilities and skills as an articulate spokesman for public education in  
Arkansas and his unique ability to work with the Arkansas General Assembly;

WHEREAS, during his career in public education Mr. Charles Knox has  
received numerous honors and awards, including being elected as President of  
the Arkansas Association of Secondary School Principals, President of the  
Arkansas Association of Educational Administrators (1980-81) which is the

2 the Arkansas Association of School Administrators (1990-91), being named as  
3 Arkansas' Superintendent of the Year in 1990-91, and serving as Assistant  
4 Executive Director of Arkansas Association of Educational Administrators  
5 since 1994; and

7 WHEREAS, Charles Knox has been a pillar of his community by serving in  
8 other leadership and civic roles as a member of the local chambers of  
9 commerce in Lonoke and in Ozark and as Chairman of the City of Cabot's Parks  
10 and Recreation Committee, and it was through his vision and creativity he was  
11 instrumental in the construction of the AAEA headquarters that are presently  
12 used by the organization,
