## HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE ADMINISTRATORS AND BOARDS OF TRUSTEES OF ARKANSAS INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO AVOID FUTURE TUITION INCREASES IN LIGHT OF THE HIGHER EDUCATION FUNDING FORMULA.

URGING THE ADMINISTRATORS AND BOARDS OF TRUSTEES OF ARKANSAS INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO AVOID FUTURE TUITION INCREASES IN LIGHT OF THE HIGHER EDUCATION FUNDING FORMULA.

WHEREAS, the Eighty-Fifth General Assembly created a funding formula for institutions of higher education; and

WHEREAS, the formula takes into account factors such as course and degree offerings, student enrollment, facility space, and degrees held by faculty; and

WHEREAS, the formula is intended to provide sufficient funding for the operation of institutions of higher education based on factors common to all institutions while accounting for differences among institutions; and

WHEREAS, the tuition rates of institutions of higher education have increased frequently in order to provide adequate funding for the institutions,

NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the House of Representatives of the State of Arkansas urges the administrators and boards of trustees of institutions of higher education to avoid increasing tuition rates, to budget institutional needs within the funding formula, and to seek other avenues of revenue increases in the event additional funding is absolutely necessary.
