For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO CREATE AN ADDITIONAL CIRCUIT JUDGESHIP
10 IN THE TWENTY-SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT; TO
11 PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND ELECTION OF THE
12 CIRCUIT JUDGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT TO CREATE AN ADDITIONAL CIRCUIT
16 JUDGESHIP IN THE TWENTY-SECOND JUDICIAL
17 DISTRICT AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE
18 APPOINTMENT AND ELECTION OF THE CIRCUIT

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-13-3103, concerning judges of the
25 Twenty-second Judicial District, is amended to add an additional subsection
26 to read as follows:

27 (e)(1) Effective July 1, 2005, there is created in the Twenty-second
28 Judicial District an additional circuit judgeship that shall have
29 jurisdiction in law, equity, probate, and juvenile matters.

30 (2) The Governor shall appoint a qualified person who is a
31 resident of the district to temporarily fill the Twenty-second Judicial
32 District circuit judgeship created by this subsection (e), and the appointed
33 person shall serve until December 31, 2006, or until a successor has been
34 elected and qualified.

35 (3)(A) The qualified electors of the district shall elect the
36 additional circuit judge created by this subsection (e) at the November 2006



1 general election to take office on January 1, 2007.

2 (B) The additional judge shall be elected from the
3 district, shall satisfy the same qualifications for holding office, and shall
4 receive the same salary, expenses, and other allowances as provided by law
5 for judges of the circuit courts.

6 (C) The judge shall serve for elected terms of six (6)
7 years.

8 (4) The county that comprises the Twenty-second Judicial
9 District shall provide courtroom and office facilities and supplies for the
10 judge of the circuit judgeship created by this subsection (e) that shall be
11 paid out of the county treasury in the same manner as other demands against
12 the county and out of funds appropriated by the quorum court of the county
13 for these purposes.

14 (5) There shall be provided for the judge of the circuit
15 judgeship created by this subsection (e) a court reporter and a trial court
16 administrative assistant whose salaries shall be fixed and paid in the manner
17 provided by law for court reporters and trial court administrative assistants
18 of the circuit courts of this state.

19
20 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
21 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Judicial Resources
22 Assessment Committee has reviewed the caseloads of the various judicial
23 districts; that the caseload of the Twenty-second Judicial District
24 necessitates the appointment of an additional circuit judge; and that this
25 act is immediately necessary to ensure the smooth, efficient, and timely
26 administration of justice in the county affected. Therefore, an emergency is
27 declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the
28 public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2005.
