22 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 19 is amended to add an 23 additional section to read as follows:

27-19-722. Foster children.

(a) If a child under the age of eighteen (18) years of age is in the custody of the Department of Human Services and is operating a motor vehicle that he or she owns, then the liability for any negligence or willful misconduct of the child shall be limited to the limits of a motor vehicle liability insurance policy that has been obtained for the benefit of the child.

22 <u>custody of the Department of Human Services and is operating a motor vehicle</u> 33 <u>that he or she does not own but has the express or implied permission of the</u>

34 <u>named insured of the motor vehicle to operate</u>, then the liability for any

35 <u>negligence or willful misconduct of the child shall be limited to the</u>

36 <u>following</u>:

1	(1) The limits of a motor vehicle liability insurance policy
2	that has been obtained for the benefit of the child; and
3	(2) The limits of a motor vehicle liability insurance policy
4	that is in effect for that motor vehicle.
