10 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO THE AREA AGENCIES

12 THE AREA AGENCIES ON AGING FUND; AND FOR OTHER

15 TO CREATE AN INCOME TAX CHECK-OFF
16 PROGRAM TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO
17 THE STATE'S AREA AGENCIES ON AGING.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 26, Chapter 51, Subchapter 4 is amended
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 26-51-453. Contribution to Arkansas Area Agencies on Aging.

26 (a)(1) The Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and
27 Administration shall include on the Arkansas individual income tax forms,
28 including those forms on which a husband and wife file separately on the same
29 form, and on all corporate income tax forms, a designation as follows:

30 "If you are entitled to a refund, check if you wish to designate []
31 \$1, [] \$5, [] \$10, [] . . . (write in amount) or [] all refund
32 due of your tax refund for the Arkansas Area Agencies on Aging to fund
33 programs and activities for senior citizens. Your refund will be reduced by
34 this amount.

35 If you owe an additional amount, check if you wish to contribute an
36 additional [] \$1, [] \$5, [] \$10, [] . . . (write in amount) for



1 the Arkansas Area Agencies on Aging to fund programs and activities for
2 senior citizens. If you wish to make a contribution to the Arkansas Area
3 Agencies on Aging, you must enclose a separate check for the amount of your
4 contribution payable to the Department of Finance and Administration."

5 (2) The Arkansas Area Agencies on Aging check-off program on
6 state income tax returns shall be effective beginning with the returns for
7 the 2005 tax year and each subsequent tax year.

8 (3) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
9 may promulgate rules and develop all income tax forms, returns, and schedules
10 necessary to implement this section.

11 (b) The department shall quarterly certify to the Treasurer of State
12 the amount contributed to the Arkansas Area Agencies on Aging through this
13 state income tax check-off during the quarter, and the Treasurer of State
14 shall deduct from the Individual Income Tax Withholding Fund the amount
15 certified.

16 (c) The Treasurer of State shall credit the amount certified each
17 quarter to the Area Agencies on Aging Fund.

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19 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 19, Subchapter 5 is amended to add an
20 additional section to read as follows:

21 19-5-1228. Area Agencies on Aging Fund.

22 (a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
23 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the Area Agencies
24 on Aging Fund. The Treasurer of State shall credit to the fund the amount
25 certified each quarter under § 26-51-453.

26 (b) The Treasurer of State shall distribute moneys in the fund to the
27 Department of Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services to be
28 distributed to the eight (8) area agencies on aging based on the Division of
29 Aging and Adult Services funding formula.
