Terms of the appointment of these clerks shall run 4 5 concurrently with the term of the Clark County District Judge. 6 (4) All municipalities located in Clark County currently 7 maintaining a docket on the court agenda, as of the effective date of this 8 subdivision (b)(4), shall be a part of the Clark County District Court System without further action on the part of the municipality. Any Clark County 9 10 municipality desiring to maintain a docket on the district court agenda may 11 do so by filing a resolution or ordinance with the district court clerk 12 requesting a docket on the court agenda. 13 (5) The annual budget of the Clark County District Court shall 14 be borne by Clark County and the participating municipalities of Clark 15 County.
