## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE NOTICE OF DEFICIENCIES TO LONGTERM CARE FACILITY RESIDENTS AND THEIR RESPONSIBLE PARTIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

THE RESIDENT'S NOTIFICATION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-10-1207 is amended to read as follows: 20-10-1207. Availability, distribution, and posting of reports and records.
(a) The Office of Long-Term Care, within ten (10) days after the date of an annual inspection visit or within thirty (30) days after the date of any interim visit, shall:
(1) forward Forward the results of all inspections of long-term care facilities to:
(1)(A) The ombudsman in whose county the inspected
facility is located; and
(2)(B) At least one (1) public library or in the absence of a public library, the county clerk in the county in which the inspected facility is located-; and
(2) Whenever the survey results include a deficiency with respect to a particular resident, notify the following in writing:
(A) The resident if he or she is competent;
(B) If the resident is not competent:
(i) The resident's legal representative; or
(ii) If no legal representative for the resident exists, the resident's responsible party and immediate family members.
