20	effective date of this act and shall serve as chair at the first meeting.		
21	(2) At the first meeting, the members of the commission shall		
22	elect from its membership a chair and other officers as needed for the		
23	transaction of its business.		
24	(3)(A) The commission shall conduct its meetings in Pulaski		
25	County at the State Capitol.		
26	(B) Meetings shall be held at least one (1) time every		
27	three (3) months, but may occur more often at the call of the chair.		
28	(d) If any vacancy occurs on the commission, the vacancy shall be		
29	filled by the same process as the original appointment.		
30	(e) The commission shall establish rules and procedures for conducting		
31	its business.		
32	(f) Members of the commission shall serve without compensation, but		
33	may receive expense reimbursement according to § 25-16-902.		
34	(g) A majority of the members of the commission shall constitute a		
35	quorum for transacting any business of the commission.		
36	(h) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall provide staff for the

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3	5-65-502. Duties of the Omnibus DWI Act Revision Commission.		
4	(a) The Omnibus DWI Act Revision Commission shall:		
5	(1) Develop a comprehensive, reorganized, revised, and		
6	<pre>modernized version of:</pre>		
7	(A) The Omnibus DWI Act, § 5-65-101 et seq.; and		
8	(B) Any other provision of law pertaining to driving under		
9	the influence of alcohol or intoxicating substances; and		
10	(2) Present the following to the Senate Interim Committee on		
11	Judiciary, the House Interim Committees on Judiciary, the Senate Interim		
12	Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor, and the House Interim		
13	Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor no later than October 1, 2006:		
14	(A) A bill draft that includes the commission's		
15	recommended legislative changes; and		
16	(B) A written explanation of the recommended legislative		
17	changes.		
18	(b) The chair of the commission shall:		
19	(1) Create subcommittees to address the different issues under		
20	the Omnibus DWI Act.		
21	(2) Appoint members to each subcommittee to review all of the		
22	laws and procedures; and		
23	(3) Allow each subcommittee to report on its proposed changes to		
24	the full commission.
