26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-19-105(a)(1)(B), concerning inmates'
29 examination and copying of public records of the Department of Correction, is
30 amended to read as follows:

31 (B)(i) However, access to inspect and copy public records of the
32 Department of Correction and the Department of Community Correction shall be
33 denied to a person who, at the time of the request, has pleaded guilty to or
34 been found guilty of a felony and is incarcerated in a correctional facility.

35 (ii) Access to inspect and copy public records
36 of the Department of Correction and the Department of Community Correction



1 shall also be denied to the representative of a person under subdivision
2 (a)(1)(B)(i) of this section unless the representative is the person's
3 attorney who is requesting information that is subject to disclosure under
4 this section.

5 (iii) Access to inspect and copy public records of the
6 Department of Correction and the Department of Community Correction shall be
7 denied to a person under subdivision (a)(1)(B)(i) of this section regardless
8 of whether the records are in the possession of the Department of Correction,
9 the Department of Community Correction, or another agency of the state.
