## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE ARKANSAS UNIVERSAL SERVICES
FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT CONCERNING THE ARKANSAS UNIVERSAL SERVICES FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-17-404(e), concerning payment from the Arkansas Universal Service Fund, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
(9)(A) Through a surcharge on its customer bills over its total customer access base, an eligible ILEC may recover any reduction in its AUSF payments up to the amount authorized by the AUSF administrator as of July l, 2005.
(B) The surcharge is not a tax.
(C)(i) For an electing company under § 23-17-401, the surcharge shall be in addition to any rate increase authorized under § 23-17401.
(ii) For a non-electing ILEC, no general rate application or earnings review shall be required to implement the surcharge.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-17-404, concerning preservation and promotion of universal service, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
(h) The commission shall adopt portability rules as necessary to allow
competitive eligible telecommunications carriers to have access to the AUSF funds of eligible telecommunications carriers receiving funds from the AUSF. The commission shall consider cost issues and quality of service issues in the rule making process.
