26	(a) There is created a Prairie Grove Battlefield State Park Advisory	
27	Commission.	
28	(b) <u>(1)</u> The <u>advisory</u> commission shall be composed of five (5) seven (<u>7)</u>
29	qualified electors of the State of Arkansas to be appointed by the Governor	
30	and shall be charged with the powers, duties, and responsibilities provided	
31	for in this subchapter serve in an advisory capacity to the State Parks	
32	Division of the Department of Parks and Tourism.	
33	(2) Four (4) of the advisory commission members shall be	
34	residents of Washington County.

(c) The members of the commission shall be appointed for five-year
 staggered terms of office.

3 (d) Vacancies on the commission caused by death, resignation, or any 4 other reason shall be filled by appointment by the Governor for the unexpired 5 portion of the term.

6 <u>(e) The commission shall advise the division in the establishment of</u> 7 policies and procedures for the development and operation of the Prairie 8 Grove Battlefield State Park. However, final authority for all matters 9 relating to the development and operation of the park shall rest with the 10 Director of the Department of Parks and Tourism.

11 (f) Under the supervision of the Superintendent of the Prairie Grove 12 Battlefield State Park and with the approval of the Director of the State 13 Parks Division of the Department of Parks and Tourism, the commission shall 14 develop and coordinate efforts to encourage gifts or donations to the park. 15

13-7-402. Officers - Oaths and compensation of members.

17 (a) Before any member of the Prairie Grove Battlefield <u>State Park</u>
18 <u>Advisory</u> Commission shall enter upon his or her duties as a member of the
19 commission, his or her shall take the oath required of elected state
20 officials and shall file a copy of the oath in the office of the Secretary of
21 State.

(b) Upon its appointment, the commission shall meet and organize by electing one (1) of its members as chair and one (1) member as secretary and shall elect any other officers as the commission deems necessary. The officers shall be elected annually.

(c) Members of the commission shall serve without compensation,
provided that the members may receive expense reimbursement in accordance
with § 25-16-901 et seq.

13-7-403. Powers and duties.

31 The Prairie Grove Battlefield Commission shall have the following 32 powers and duties:

33 (1) To acquire and develop such lands and improvements thereon
 34 and monuments adjacent to the present Prairie Grove Battleground Park located

35 in Washington County as the commission deems necessary to preserve and

36 develop it as a proper memorial to the officers and men of the Confederacy

2	(2) To convey any and all of the land and other property

19	13-7-404. Acquisition of land.
20	(a) Before the Prairie Grove Battlefield Commission shall buy any land
21	under the provisions of this subchapter, the commission shall cause an
22	appraisal of the land to be made by three (3) qualified and impartial
23	appraisers, and the commission shall not pay any greater price for the land
24	than the appraised value thereof.
25	(b) If the owner or owners of the land refuse to sell it to the
26	commission or if they seek a greater price than the appraised value of the
27	land, the commission may acquire the land by condemnation as authorized in §
28	13-7-403 and pay for the land at the price fixed by the court.
29	(c)(l) All suits for the condemnation of property under the provisions
30	of this subchapter shall be brought in the name of the State of Arkansas for
31	the use and benefit of the commission.
32	(2) Before any suit can be brought, it shall be necessary for
33	the commission to unanimously pass a resolution to that effect setting forth
34	the necessity and purpose for which the land is to be condemned, together

7	13-7-405. Payment for land acquired.
8	(a) When the Prairie Grove Battlefield Commission shall have
9	ascertained the description of the lands to be acquired and shall have
10	satisfied itself as to the title thereto and the amount of payment to be made
11	to the owner or owners of the lands, the commission shall certify to the
12	Auditor of State its findings, giving the name of the landowner, the
13	description of the land involved, and the compensation due the landowner.
14	(b) When these facts shall have been certified to the Auditor of
15	State, the Auditor of State shall draw his or her warrant against the
16	appropriation made for that purpose for the amount due the landowner and the
17	Treasurer of State shall pay the amount of the warrant or voucher upon
18	presentation.
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
