Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ARKANSAS WINE PRODUCERS COUNCIL SHALL CONSIST OF TEN (10) MEMBERS WITH FOUR (4) OF THE MEMBERS RECOMMENDED BY THE ARKANSAS ASSOCIATION OF GRAPE GROWERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROVIDE THAT THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ARKANSAS WINE PRODUCERS COUNCIL SHALL CONSIST OF TEN (10) MEMBERS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-5-701 is amended to read as follows:
3-5-701. Creation - Members.
(a)(1) There is created the Arkansas Wine Producers Council to be composed of seven (7) ten (10) members.
(2) Four (4) members of the council shall be appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate from a list of two (2) names submitted by the Arkansas Wine Producers Association for each of the four (4) positions to be filled.
(3) One (1) member shall be appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate from a list of two (2) names submitted by the Arkansas State Horticulture Society. Four (4) members of the council shall be appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate from a list of two (2) names submitted by the Arkansas Association of Grape Growers for each of the four (4) positions to be filled.
(4) One (1) member of the council shall be designated by the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas and shall be a faculty member or administrator who is knowledgeable in viniculture.
(5) One (l) member shall be designated by the State Parks, Recreation, and Travel Commission, and the member shall be either a member or employee of the commission.
(b) All successor members shall be appointed or designated for terms of three (3) years.
