19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-21-303 is amended to read as follows:

22 6-21-303. Rules and regulations.

23 ~~(a)~~ The board of directors of each school district shall prescribe the
24 method of soliciting bids by regulation and may adopt other rules and
25 regulations governing the procurement of commodities.

26 ~~(b)(1)(A) Each school district, according to its established~~
27 ~~reimbursement policy, shall provide to each prekindergarten through sixth-~~
28 ~~grade teacher in each fiscal year the greater of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per~~
29 ~~student enrolled in the teacher's class at the end of the three (3) months of~~
30 ~~the school year or five hundred dollars (\$500) per classroom for the teacher~~
31 ~~to apply toward the purchase of related commodities for use by that teacher~~
32 ~~in his or her classroom or for class activities.~~

33 ~~(B) The teacher must provide to the school district~~
34 ~~receipts documenting any purchase.~~

35 ~~(C) Each fiscal year, the superintendent of each school~~
36 ~~district shall provide a statement to the State Board of Education attesting~~



1 ~~to the district's compliance with this section and shall attach any~~
2 ~~supporting documents that the state board may require by regulation.~~

3 ~~(2) The board of directors of each school district shall adopt~~
4 ~~reasonable procedures for teachers to draw from or be reimbursed from the~~
5 ~~discretionary fund pursuant to this subsection.~~

6 ~~(c) The Department of Education shall have the authority to grant a~~
7 ~~waiver of the requirements of subsection (b) of this section if a school~~
8 ~~district requests a waiver and the school district is in fiscal distress.~~
