SENATE BILL 1125

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR STATEWIDE STANDARDS FOR AND OVERSIGHT OF SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-20-708 is amended to read as follows:
6-20-708. Appropriation of state funds authorized.
There is authorized to be appropriated from time to time out of money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated such sums as may be necessary to enable the:
(1) State Board of Education to provide for the establishment, maintenance, operation, and expansion of school lunch programs, including, but not limited to, the payment of administrative expenses and the matching or supplementing of federal funds; and
(2) Department of Health to carry out the responsibilities set out in § 6-20-709.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 20, Subchapter 7 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-20-709. Department of Health oversight.
(a) No elementary school, middle school, junior high school, or high
school may serve lunch to students unless the lunch menu has been submitted to and approved by the Department of Health either:
(1) Every Friday for the following school week; or
(2) On or before the 29 th of the month for the following month. (b) The Department of Health shall promulgate rules for:
(1) Receiving, reviewing, and approving or disapproving each
public school lunch menu; and
(2) Reporting all findings to the Department of Education.
