19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-53-210 is amended to read as follows:
22 27-53-210. Copies - Fee.

23 (a) Photostatic or written copies of reports and records may be
24 obtained from the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police, or
25 from his duly designated assistants, by any person who shall request the
26 department for them in writing.

27 (b)(1) In order to partially reimburse the department for the cost of
28 making photostatic or written copies of motor vehicle accident reports and of
29 records of traffic violations, there shall be charged a fee of ten dollars
30 (\$10.00) for each copy of a basic accident report and one dollar and fifty
31 cents (\$1.50) per page for each copy of supplemental reports.

32 (2) All funds collected under this subsection shall immediately
33 be paid over by the department to the Treasurer of State and shall be
34 credited by him as a special revenue to the Department of Arkansas State
35 Police Fund.

36 (c)(1) In order to partially reimburse county and municipal law



1 enforcement agencies for the cost of making copies of motor vehicle accident
2 reports and copies of records of traffic violations, there shall be charged a
3 fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each copy of a basic accident report and a
4 fee of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per page for each copy of a
5 supplemental report.

6 (2) All funds collected under this subsection shall be retained
7 by the municipality or county for the support of the law enforcement agency.
