## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO BE KNOWN AS THE "TIRE SAFETY ACT OF  
10 2005".

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
18

19 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Tire  
20 Safety Act of 2005".  
21

22 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 37, Subchapter 4 is amended  
23 to add an additional section to read as follows:

24 27-37-403. (a) No person shall sell, offer for sale, give away, or  
25 have in his or her possession with intent to sell or give away a tire for use  
26 on any motor vehicle, all-terrain vehicle, farm tractor, motorized off-road  
27 equipment, or trailer, if the tire has been marked "blem", "second",  
28 "imperfect", or any similar appropriate descriptive term.

29 (b) A violation of this section is a Class B misdemeanor.
