21	SECTION 1. Uncodified § 88 of Act 1273 of 2003, as amended, is amend	ed
22	to read as follows:	.00
23	SECTION 88. Effective date. It is found and determined by the Eight	.v-
24	fourth General Assembly that the Streamlined Sales Tax Agreement is necessa	-
25	in order to stop the loss of sales tax revenue due to the rapid growth of	•
26	internet sales, to level the playing field between local businesses and out	:-
27	of-state businesses, and to negate the undue burden on interstate commerce;	
28	and that this act is necessary in order for Arkansas to be in compliance wi	th
29	the Streamlined Sales Tax Agreement. Under the Streamlined Sales Tax	
30	Agreement, when at least ten (10) states comprising at least twenty percent	
31	(20%) of the total population, as determined by the 2000 Federal census, of	:
32	all states imposing a state sales tax have petitioned for membership and ha	ve
33	been found to be in compliance with the requirements of the agreement, the	
34	agreement will become effective unless a specific effective date is otherwi	.se
35	given. While these contingencies have not been met, it is anticipated that	<u>-</u>
36	they will be met on July 1, 2005. In order for Arkansas to be one (1) of t	he

1	governing states to the agreement, it must be in compliance with the
2	Streamlined Sales Tax Agreement by July 1, 2005. Therefore, the provisions
3	of this act shall become effective either on the effective date specified in
4	that section or, if no effective date is listed in the section, then on $\frac{1}{2}$
5	first day of the first quarter following the effective date of the
6	Streamlined Sales Tax Agreement July 1, 2005.
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8	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
9	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this state is losing sales tax
10	revenue due to the rapid growth of Internet sales; that several states have
11	joined together and drafted a Streamlined Sales Tax Agreement to simplify and
12	modernize sales and use tax administration in order to substantially reduce
13	the burden of tax compliance; that it is anticipated that the required number
14	of states will be found to be in compliance with the Streamlined Sales Tax
15	Agreement as of July 1, 2005; that those states found to be in compliance as
16	of July 1, 2005, will become the governing board for the Streamlined Sales
17	Tax Agreement; and that this act is necessary in order for Arkansas to become
18	one of the governing states to the Streamlined Sales Tax Agreement.
19	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for
20	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
21	effective on July 1, 2005.
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
