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1 (a) In addition to the authority of school districts under § 6-13-620 2 to have the care and custody of the schoolhouse, grounds, and other property belonging to the district, the board of directors for any Arkansas school 3 4 district shall be authorized and empowered to acquire and hold real estate, 5 tenements, hereditaments, and other real property as is necessary and proper 6 for the purposes of the education of pupils of the district and the 7 administration of the schools of the district.
